A GDS commitment is a concrete pledge by an organisation, government, or institution to take action to make society more inclusive for persons with disabilities. These commitments can be policies, projects, or initiatives aimed at drivi

To make a meaningful impact, commitments should follow these principles:

SMART

Specific, Measurable, Achievable, Relevant, and Time-bound

CRPD-Aligned

Based on international disability rights standards

OPD-Inclusive

Developed with the active involvement of Organisations of Persons with Disabilities (OPDs)









Added Value

Bringing new or improved solutions for inclusion

Addressing Gaps

Filling critical needs and removing barriers

Why Are GDS Commitments Important?


They help ensure disability inclusion is part of all development efforts.
